Dear middle school teachers:

The purpose of this teacher's guide is to offer a brief overview of what to expect during the upcoming assembly at your school.

“H2O, Where Did You Go?” (Middle School Version) is an interactive assembly that is appropriate for grades 6-8. The program is approximately 45 minutes in length.



Topics addressed in the assembly:

- Water continually cycles among land, ocean, and atmosphere via transpiration, evaporation, condensation and precipitation, as well as downhill flows on land.
- The value of freshwater in Southern California
- Sources of freshwater
- The importance of water conservation
- Desalination - why and how
- How to be “WaterSmart”

Two assembly performers, Mark Beckwith and Obediah Thomas (or Rebecca Lynn and Obediah Thomas) use a gameshow, music, student role-playing, and stories to engage and motivate students.
