



Teacher's Guide for the Assembly

"VOICES FOR GOOD CHOICES"

The "Voices for Good Choices" assembly (formerly titled "Characters for Good Character") by the [Razzle Bam Boom](#) duo is appropriate for grades K-6. The purpose of this guide is to offer teachers an advanced assembly overview, five of the key vocabulary terms that will be used during the performance, and a few suggested activities to do following the performance.



"Voices for Good Choices" focuses on defining, demonstrating, and encouraging the good character traits: **kindness**, **responsibility**, **teamwork**, **respect**, and **perseverance**. Regarding the concepts of responsibility, teamwork, and respect, Mark and Obediah will make the point that one can behave with responsibility and respect toward others, and behave with responsibility and respect toward our environment as well.

The presentation uses music, humor, and plenty of audience participation. Mark and Obediah will invite students to the stage to perform throughout the show. We understand that students may be educated about these character/values concepts by teachers, but as you will see, our teaching approach will be different. It is our hope that when a student is confronted with a decision that requires kindness, responsibility, teamwork, respect, or perseverance, they may fondly recall something that occurred during our performance.

Post-performance suggestions for the classroom:

- Discuss one of the character traits addressed during our presentation.
- Have older students write an essay about something they can do to be more responsible, etc.
